Chord/Scale Relationships

Level 1

Identify the most appropriate scale for playing over one of the following chord types : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented 7, and diminished 7th chords.

Level 2

Identify the most appropriate scale for playing over one of the following chord types : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented 7, and diminished 7th, 7b9#11, 7#11, Major7#11 and Minor 11 chords.

Level 3

Identify the most appropriate scale for playing over one of the following chord types : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented 7, and diminished 7th, 7b9#11, 7#11, Major7#11 and Minor 11, 13(#11), 7(#9), Major 7 (#5), Minor(Maj7), Minor(Maj9), Minor b6 and Minor 7b5 (natural 2) chords.

Intervals

Level 1

Identify or click in the interval on the treble or bass clef. Includes : Ascending Perfect - 4ths, 5ths, octaves, Major - 2nds, 3rds, 6ths, 7ths. Intervals will start from the tonic, in major and minor keys with up to 3 #s and bs.

Level 2

Identify or click in the interval on the treble or bass clef. Includes : Ascending and descending - Perfect - 4ths, 5ths, octaves, Major - 2nds, 3rds, 6ths, 7ths, Minor - 2nds, 3rds, 6ths, 7ths. Intervals will start from the tonic, in major and minor keys with up to 4 #s and bs.

Level 3

Identify or click in the interval on the treble or bass clef. Includes all ascending and descending simple chromatic intervals. Intervals will start from the tonic, in major and minor keys with up to 5 #s and bs.

Jazz Chord Symbols

Level 1

Identify the chord symbol that best represents the displayed chord, or identify the notes in the given chord symbol, or click in the notes of the given chord symbol, including the following chords : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, sus4, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented, and diminished 7th chords.

Level 2

Identify the chord symbol that best represents the displayed chord, or identify the notes in the given chord symbol, or click in the notes of the given chord symbol, including the following chords : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, sus4, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented, diminished 7th, augmented 7th, 7b9, 7#11, Major7#11 and Minor 11 chords.

Level 3

Jazz Chords

Level 1

Identify or click in the following chords : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, sus4, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented, and diminished 7th chords.

Level 2

Identify or click in the following chords : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, sus4, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented, diminished 7th, augmented 7th, 7b9, 7#11, Major7#11 and Minor 11 chords.

Level 3

Identify or click in the following chords : Major 7, Major 9, Major (add 9), Major 6/9, 7, 9, Minor 7, Minor 9, sus4, 7sus4, Minor 7 (b5), augmented, diminished 7th, augmented 7th, 7b9, 7#11, Major7#11, Minor 11, 13(#11), 7(#9), 7(b9 #11), 7sus b9, Major 7 (#5), Minor(Maj7), Minor(Maj9), and Minor 7b5 (natural 2) chords.

Jazz Scales

Level 1

Click in, or identify the following ascending scales on the treble or bass clef, in keys with up to 3 #s and bs : all major scale modes + harmonic minor, melodic minor, chromatic, wholetone, major pentatonic, minor pentatonic and blues scales.

Level 2

Click in, or identify the following ascending or descending scales on the treble or bass clef, in keys with up to 4 #s and bs : all major scale modes + harmonic minor, melodic minor, chromatic, wholetone, major pentatonic, minor pentatonic, blues, dominant pentatonic, major bebop, minor bebop, dominant bebop, and Spanish scales.

Level 3

Click in, or identify the following ascending or descending scales on the treble or bass clef, in keys with up to 5 #s and bs : All major scale modes + harmonic minor, melodic minor, chromatic, wholetone, major pentatonic, minor pentatonic, blues, dominant pentatonic, major bebop, minor bebop, dominant bebop, Spanish, diminished, diminished wholetone, half tone/whole tone, locrian (natural 2), lydian augmented, and lydian dominant scales.

Scale Home Keys

Level 1

Identify the home scale of the given scale/mode. Scales will include : all major scale modes.

Level 2

Identify the home scale and degree of the given scale/mode. Scales will include : all major scale modes,+ lydian dominant, and Spanish scales.

Level 3

Identify the home scale and degree of the given scale/mode. Scales will include : all major scale modes,+ lydian dominant, lydian augmented, locrian (natural 2), diminished wholetone, and Spanish scales.
