Drum stickings, and 2 bar combinations of drum stickings containing 4 quaver triplets or 4 semiquavers, leading with the left or right hand, and including single paradiddles, double paradiddles, triple paradiddles and paradiddle-diddles. Patterns are to be tapped 4 times. Tempo = 70/60.
